RIVERBANK FOOTBRIDGE OPEN 12 NOON SUNDAY

The new Riverbank Footbridge will open permanently for the public to use and enjoy from midday tomorrow, Sunday, 9 March.

The opening follows the completion of a significant construction milestone and will provide what will prove to be a popular pedestrian and cyclist link in the Riverbank Precinct and convenient access to the redeveloped Adelaide Oval.

Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) Chief Executive, Rod Hook said the footbridge will provide direct, unimpeded access for commuters taking trains and trams and for general access to the city.

"The community will be able to access the new footbridge for upcoming events at Adelaide Oval, including the Rolling Stones concert on Saturday, 22 March and the start of the new AFL season the following week," he said.

"Over the next few weeks a number of features that will further enhance the amenity and use of the bridge will be completed.

"These include completion of the bridge's glass cladding, landscaping and installation of the water features."
