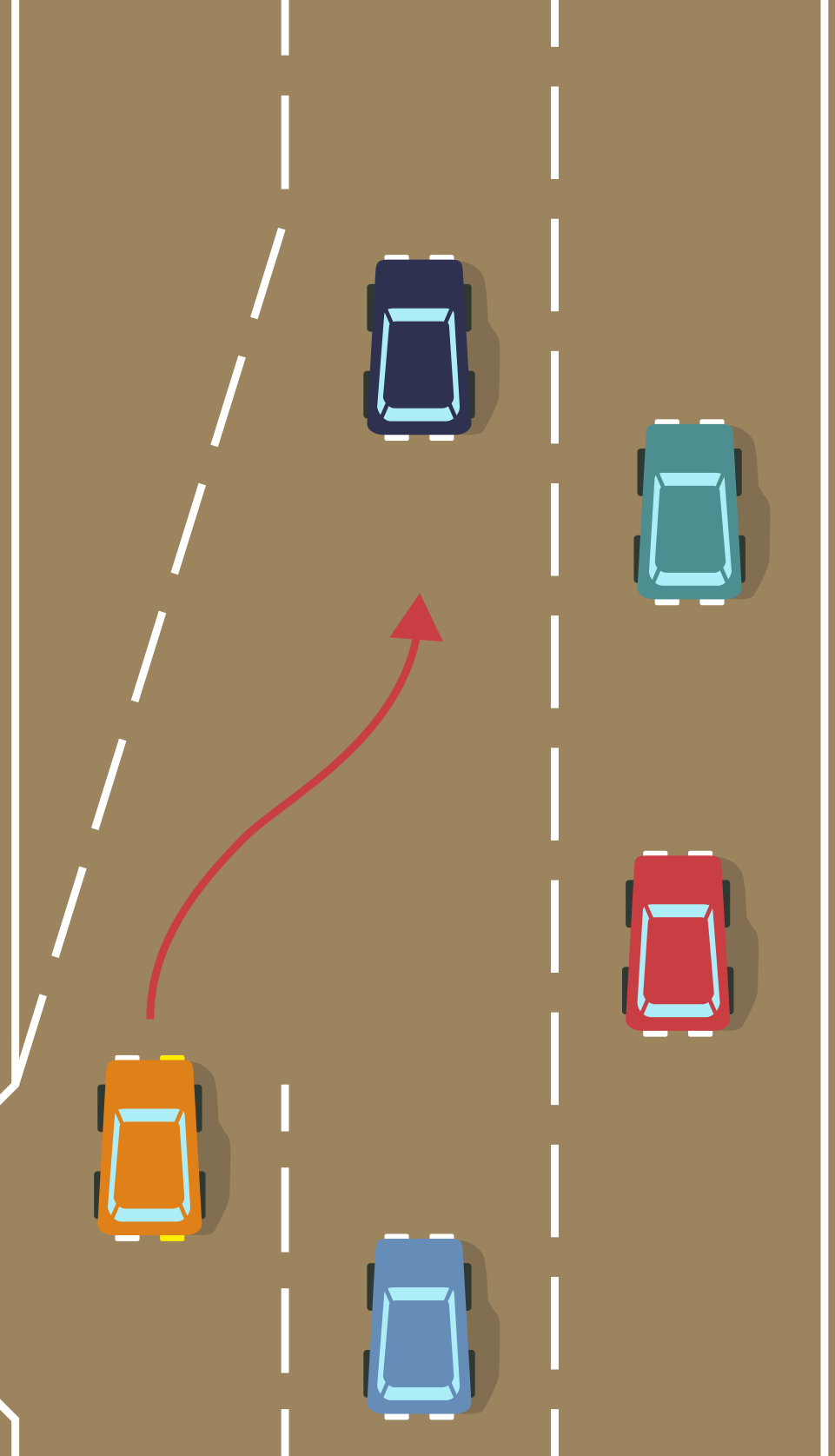


OPERATION MOVING TRAFFIC

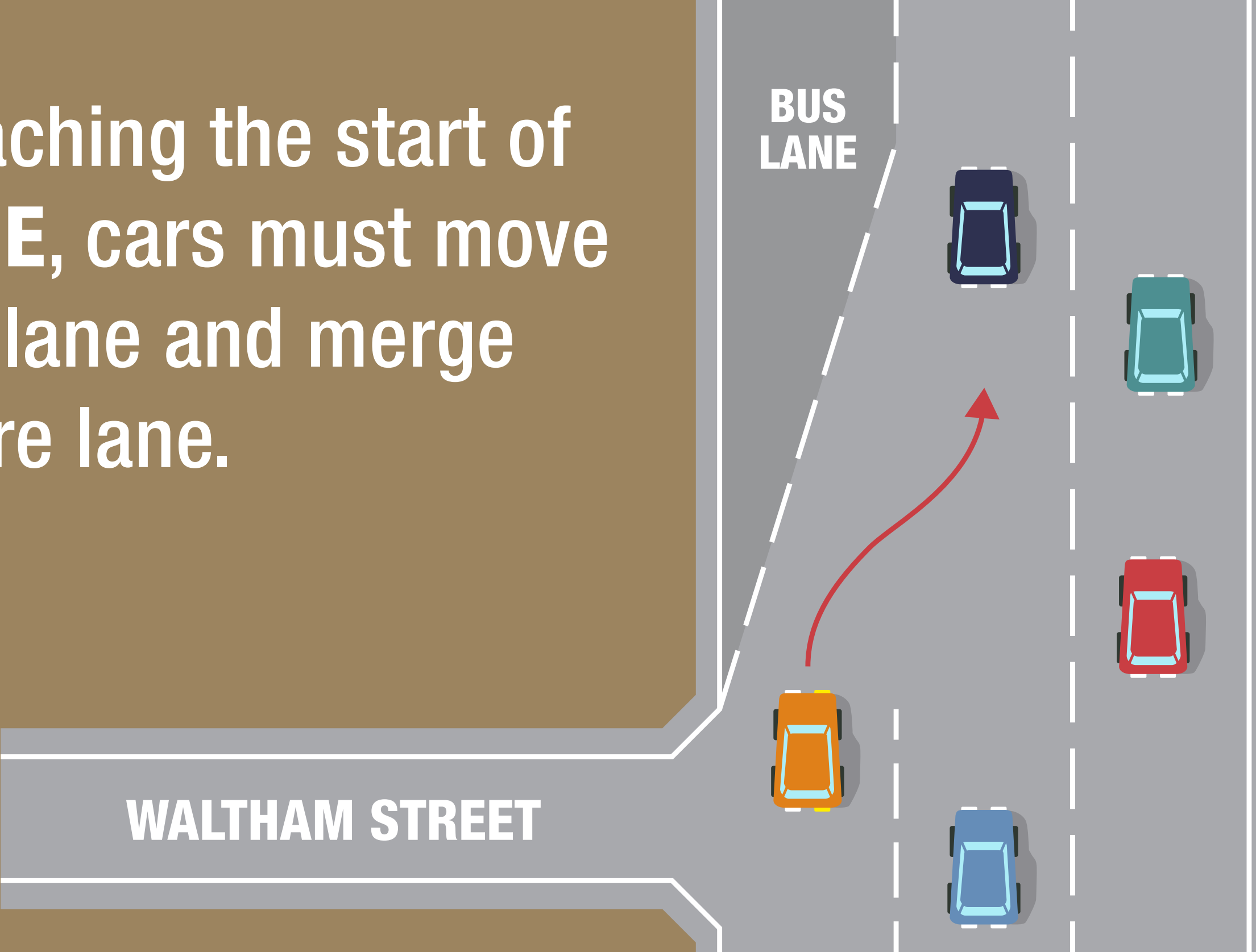
Setback Bus Lanes ANZAC HIGHWAY



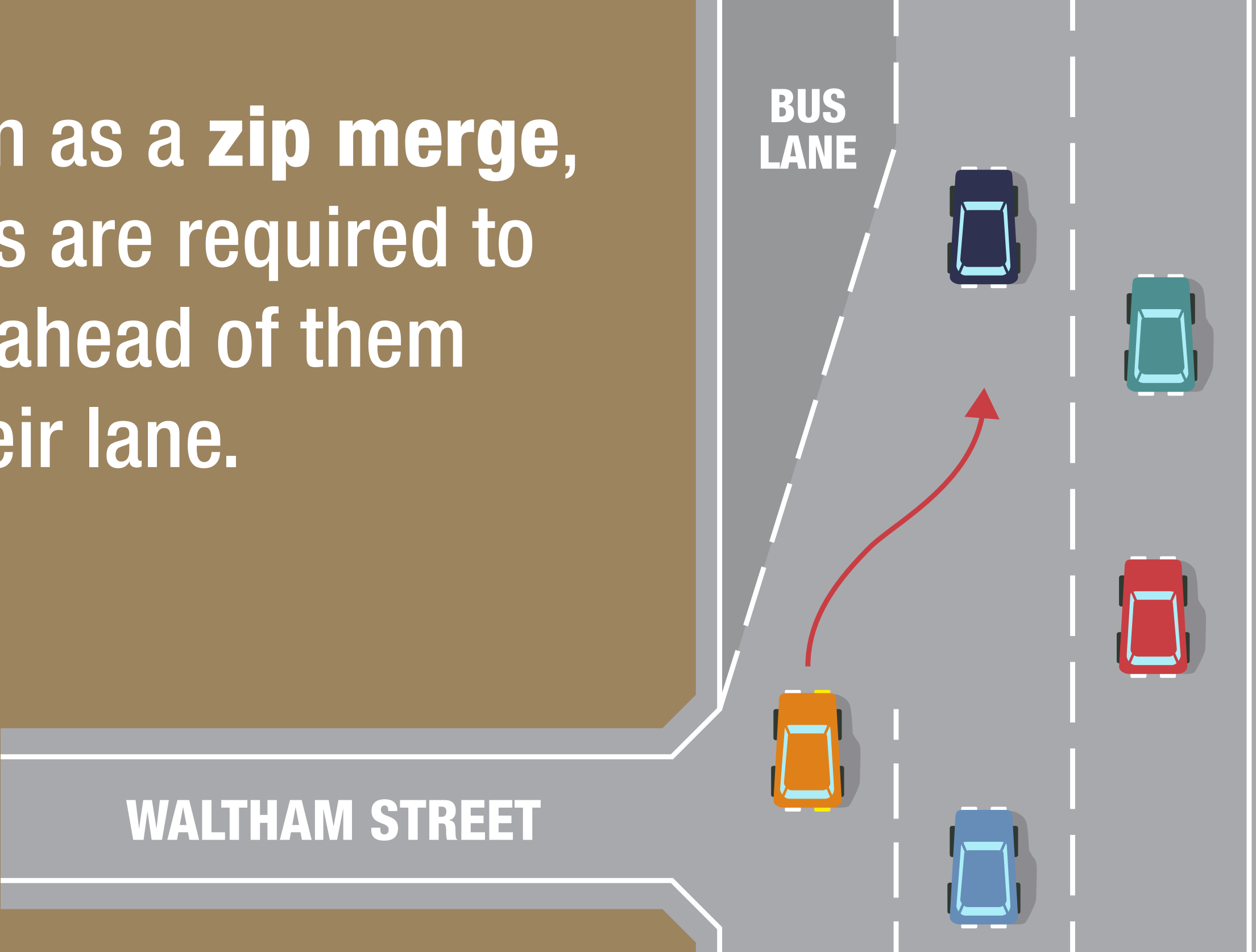
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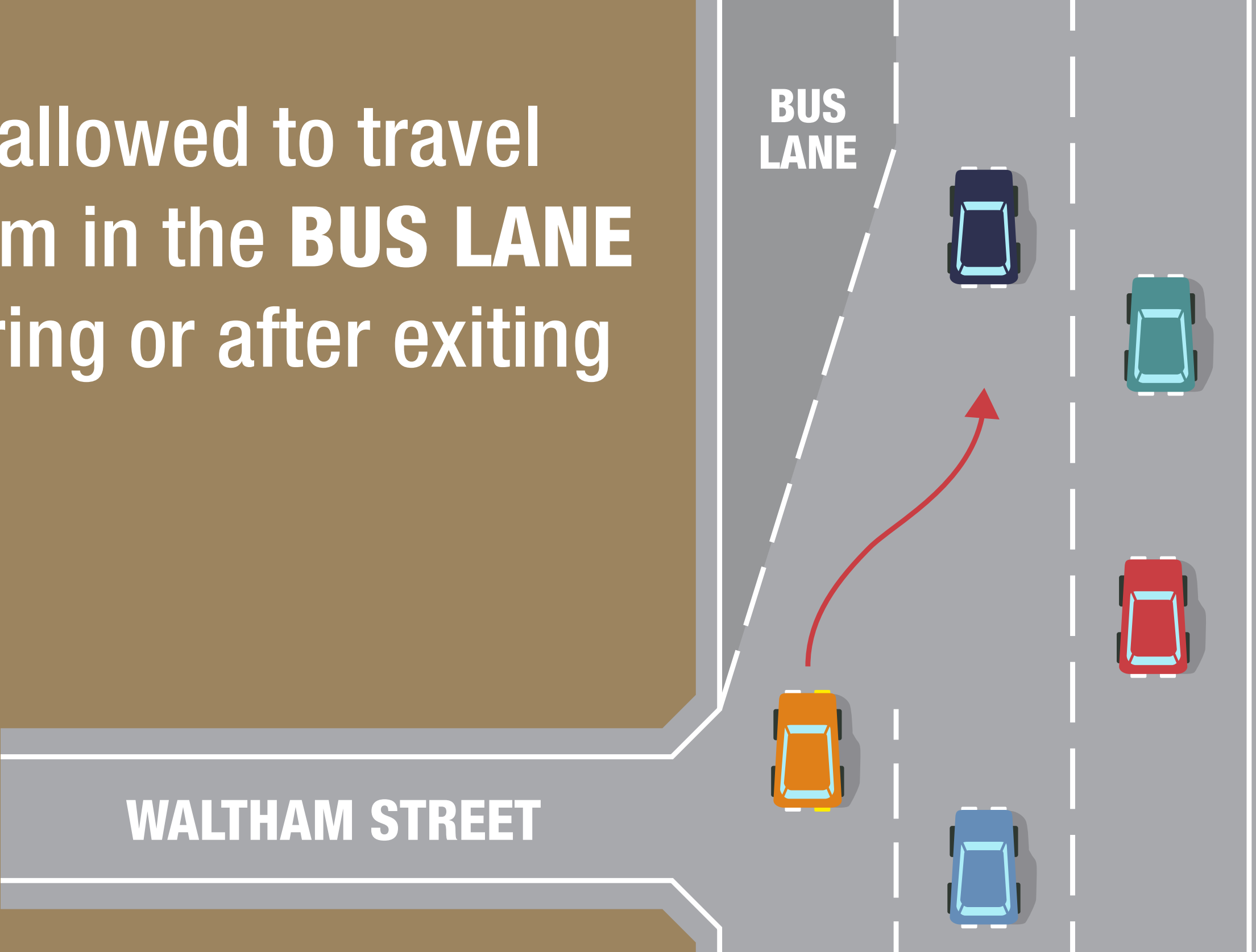
When approaching the start of the **BUS LANE**, cars must move from the left lane and merge into the centre lane.



This is known as a **zip merge**, where drivers are required to let a vehicle ahead of them enter into their lane.



Vehicles are allowed to travel for up to 100m in the **BUS LANE** prior to entering or after exiting a side street.

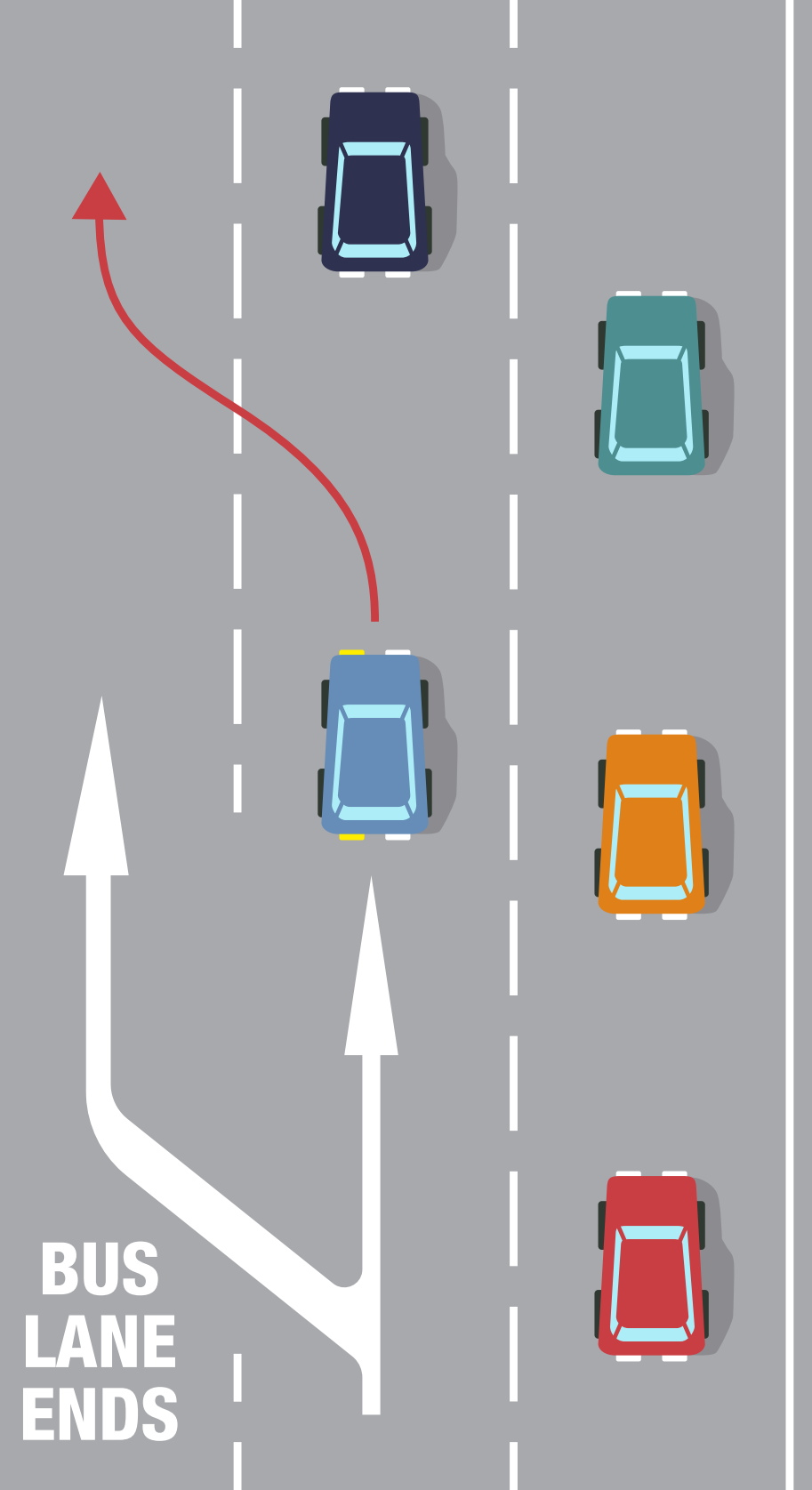


When the **BUS LANE** ends, drivers are encouraged to use all lanes on the approach to the intersection.



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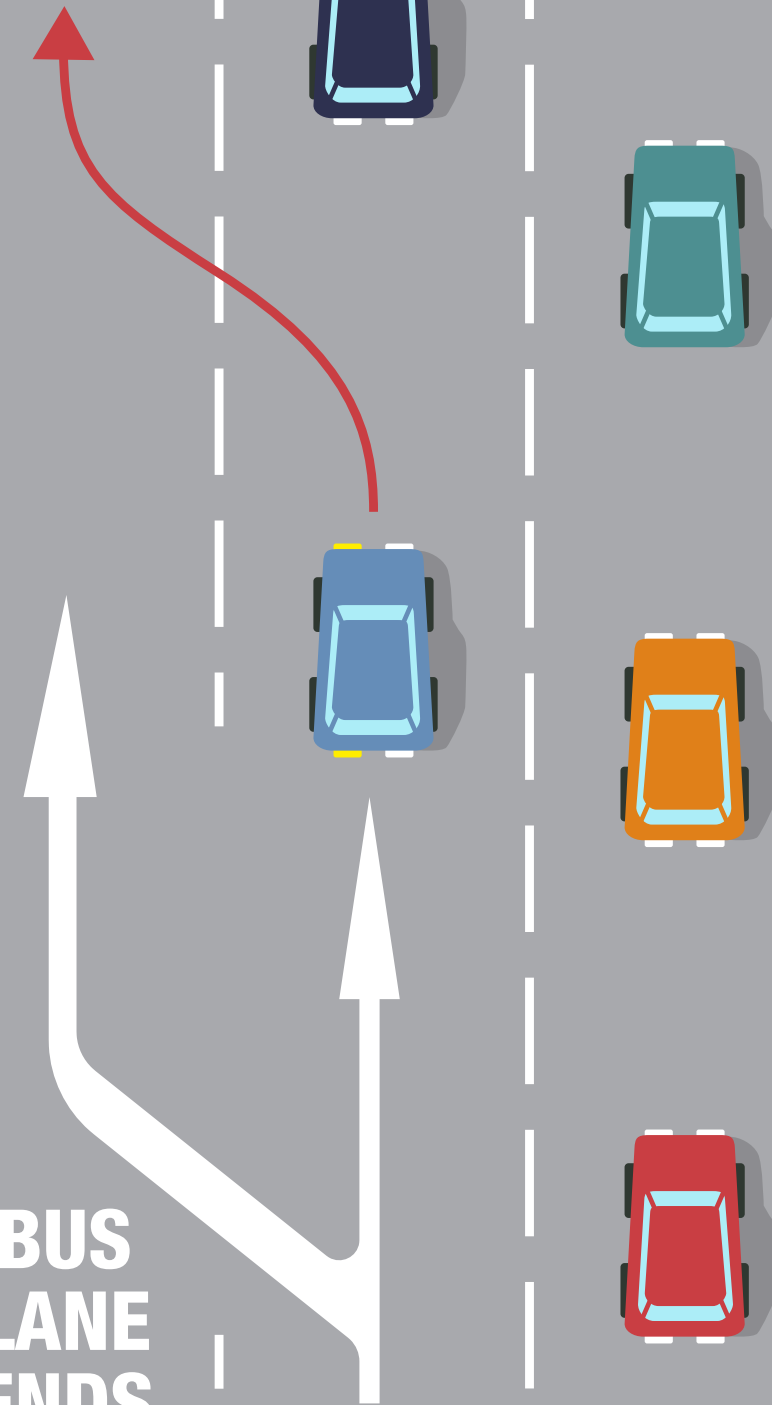
Using all lanes gets more vehicles through on the green signal.



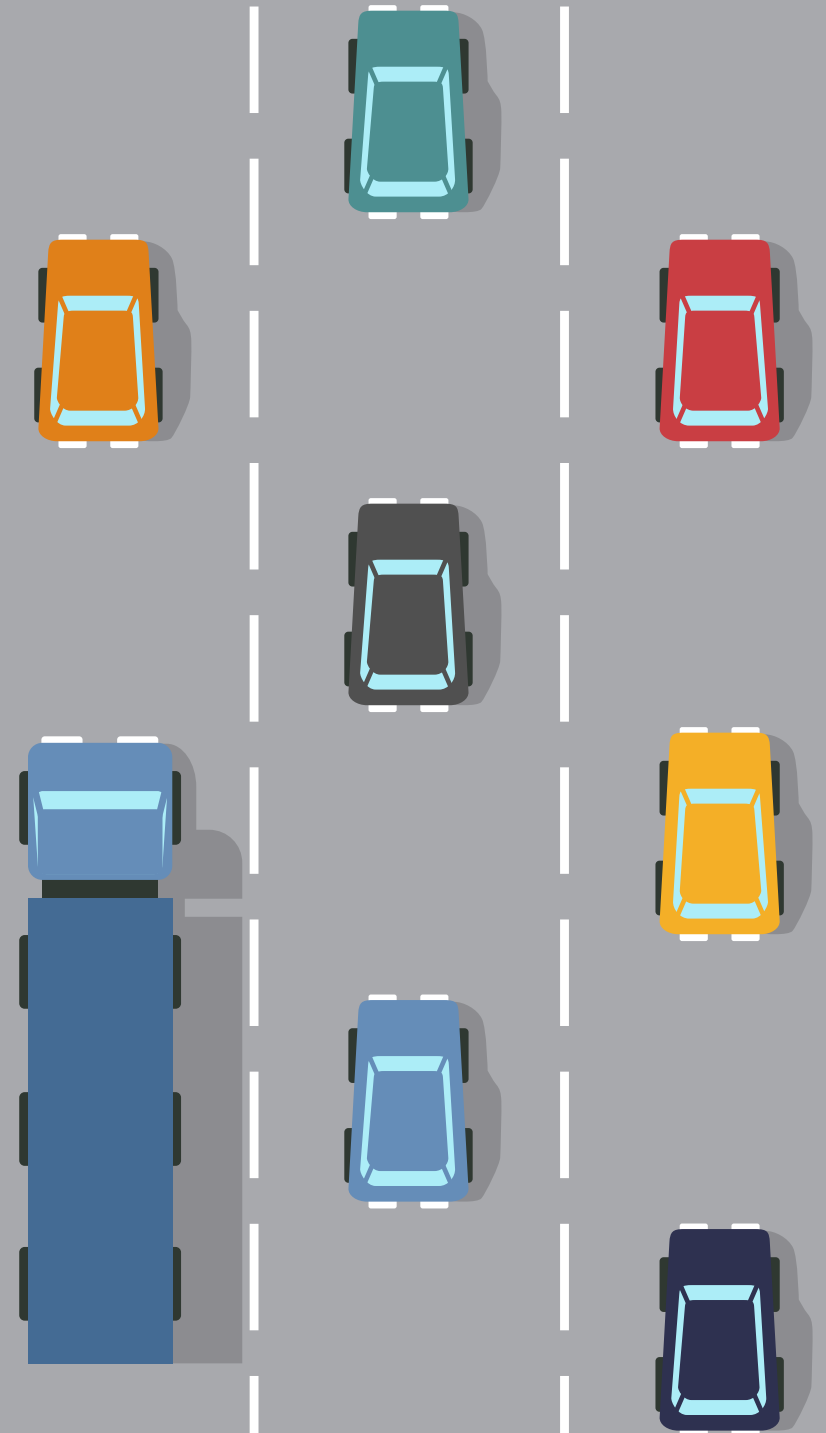
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**BUS

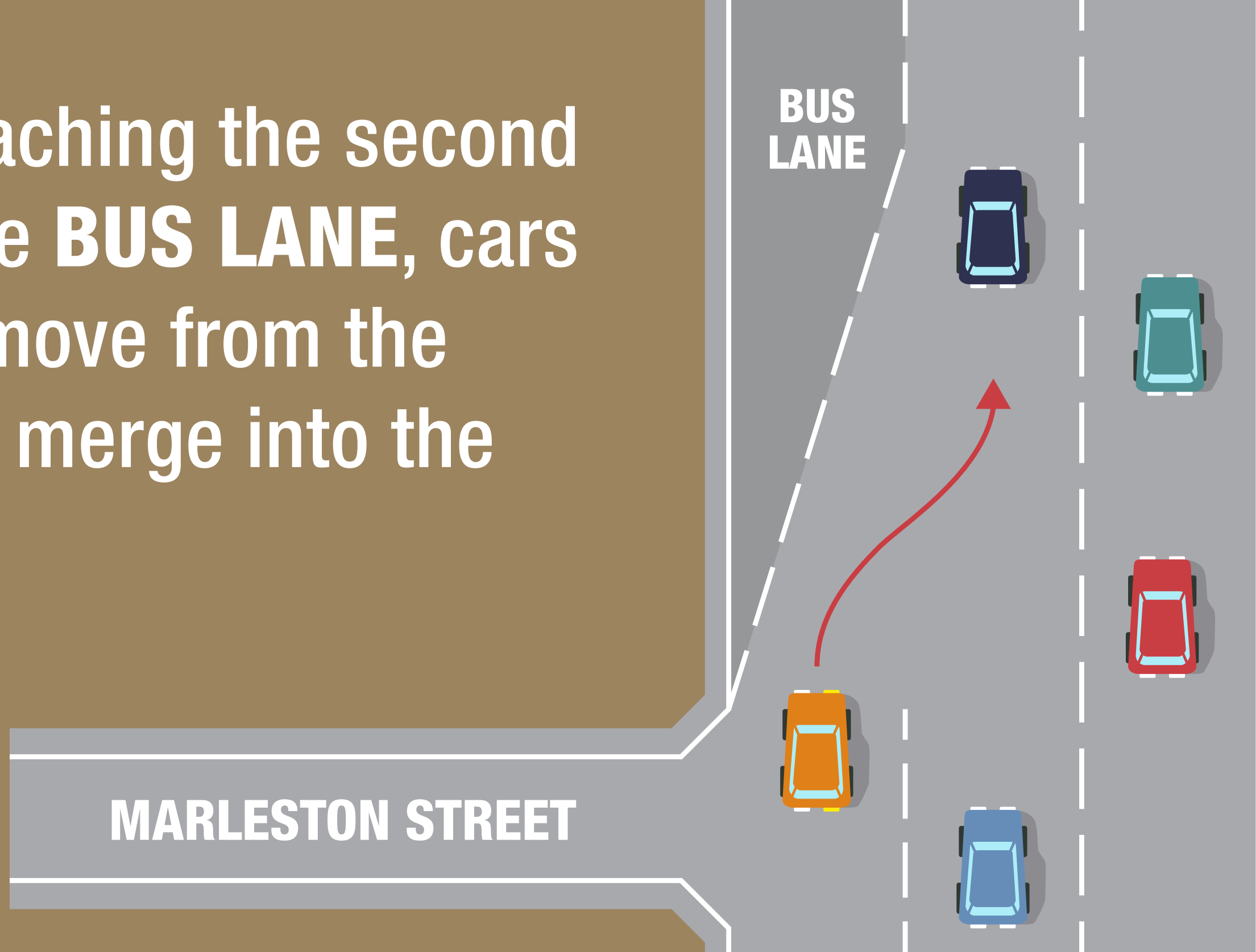
Cars can now use all three lanes through the traffic signals when travelling between the two sections of **BUS LANE**.



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When approaching the second section of the **BUS LANE**, cars must again move from the left lane and merge into the centre lane.



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The **BUS LANE** ends, traffic can move into the left lane again or stay in the centre lane.



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
