Darlington Upgrade Project

Pedestrian Detour Sturt Road, Tonsley



As part of the Darlington Upgrade Project, a detour for pedestrians on the northern side of Sturt Road between Bradley Grove and Main South Road, Tonsley, will be implemented from 7am on Monday 22 January 2018 for approximately four weeks.

Pedestrians using this section of Sturt Road will be detoured via Bradley Grove, Lynton Avenue, Birch Crescent, Oak Avenue and Maple Avenue, as outlined on the plan overleaf.

The detour is required in order to safely facilitate road, kerb and footpath reconstruction on this section of Sturt Road. These works will be undertaken Monday to Friday between the hours of 7am and 6pm.

Three nights of work will be required at some stage throughout this period, likely late January 2018. The project team will notify adjacent residents once the date has been confirmed.

Excavators, a roller, a crane, trucks, light towers, a profiler and an asphalt machine will be used to undertake these works.

The project team will liaise directly with property owners whose driveways will be affected by the works.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time, take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed and lane restrictions when travelling through the area.

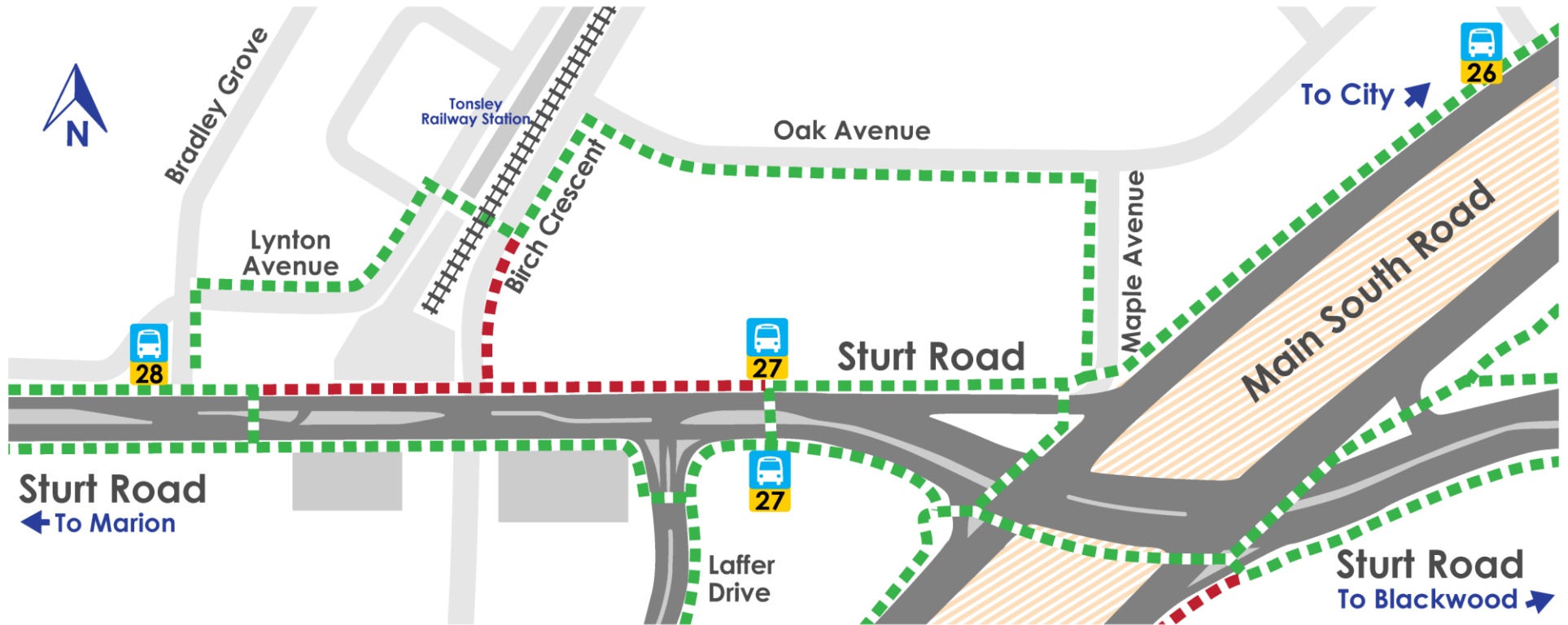
