

Gawler Rail Electrification Project

Works Notification

As part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project, works will be undertaken within the rail corridor at Prospect.

Location: Between Elizabeth Street and Winter Terrace, Prospect, working progressively along the corridor (refer to map below).

When: From Monday, 25 November, for approximately five weeks, weather permitting.

Work hours: Monday to Saturday between 7am and 7pm.

Please note there will be no disruption to passenger services during this works program.



Things you need to know:

- Works involve trenching within the rail corridor to install a new underground services route to support a new signalling system and construction of concrete footings to support the masts and overhead wiring structures.
- Local traffic management will be required with some speed restrictions in place, please follow signage.
- Site set up will include a small amenity block and stockpiles within the rail corridor. These will be removed at the conclusion of the works program.
- No vegetation will be trimmed or removed as part of these works.
- Further works will be required in this area to install masts, overhead wiring and fencing. The Project Team will provide more detailed information about this as they are planned.

Work crews will make every effort to minimise the disturbance to residents and businesses. Thank you for your patience as we undertake this important project.
