

# Flagstaff Road Upgrade Project

## Upcoming changes to traffic conditions

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is upgrading Flagstaff Road, between Hyland Avenue and Bonneyview Road. The South Australian government has committed \$32.9 million to deliver this program of work, which will improve travel times, capacity and safety for all users. The upgrade involves the installation of a fourth lane to make it a permanent two-way carriageway.

Over the coming weeks the following works will be undertaken:

- construction of the Shared Use Pedestrian Bridge and on road bicycle lane;
- installation of the Shared Use Path on the eastern side of Flagstaff Road;
- temporary line marking;
- installation of electrical conduit;
- installation of drainage; and
- asphalt placement.

To safely facilitate these works, traffic will be switched to the final road alignment, in which, northbound traffic will travel along the western side of Flagstaff Road and southbound traffic will travel along the eastern side of Flagstaff Road. The switch will allow finishing works to be carried out in the centre median of Flagstaff Road.

This traffic switch will occur **after 10am on Monday, 21 February 2022, weather permitting**. During this time, Flagstaff Road will remain open with speed restrictions in place. **From 3pm** traffic will travel along the final road alignment, one lane in each direction. No road closures or detours will occur as part of this change. This traffic arrangement will remain in place until early April when both lanes, in each direction, become operational.

Please see the maps over the page for traffic, pedestrian, cyclist and local access information. There is no change to public transport services. Access for emergency service vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Please be advised that there will be occasions when speed and lane restrictions are in place. One lane in each direction will be open to traffic at all times. Traffic management and signage will be in place to alert road users to changed traffic conditions.

### Permanent change to local access

Following the completion of the traffic switch on **Monday, 21 February 2022**, residents located between Main South Road and Elly Court (number 2 to 16 Flagstaff Road), are reminded that right turn movements from Flagstaff Road southbound to access properties will be permanently removed as per the final road alignment. This traffic arrangement allows for the construction of a new centre median along Flagstaff Road.

Permanent access for these properties from Flagstaff Road southbound will be via a U-turn at Elly Court. Residents are asked to view the map overleaf to familiarise themselves with the permanent traffic access information.

**Ongoing day works**

Day works will continue from Monday to Saturday, between 7am and 6pm as we work towards project completion in mid 2022. Flagstaff Road will remain open during day works with speed and lane restrictions in place. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained under all traffic conditions, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access. Local access will be maintained at all times.

You may also notice some odour which is common when asphaltting works are underway.

The Department appreciates your co-operation and patience while these important works are undertaken.

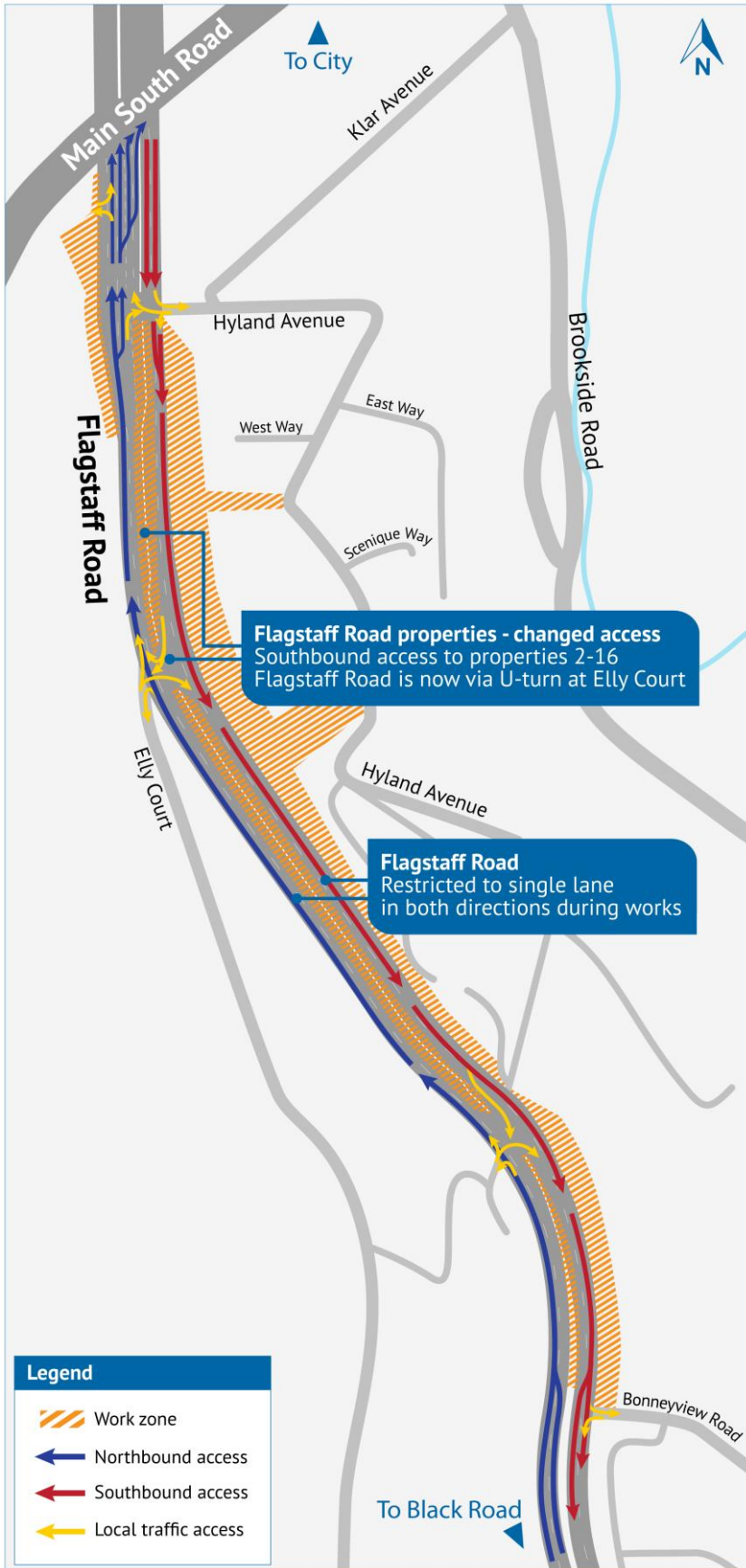
