Princes Highway Upgrade

The Springs Road and Burrungule Road intersection upgrade

Improving long term safety and efficiency for all road users

We are delivering infrastructure upgrades on the Princes Highway, from Meningie to the South Australian/Victorian border. These upgrades are jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian governments (80:20).

What's happening

We are undertaking asphalt pavement works on Princes Highway at the intersection with The Springs Road and Burrungule Road to improve road quality and safety at this intersection.

How this affects you

Major works to upgrade this intersection are continuing. To keep everyone safe there will be changes to traffic conditions throughout the duration of works. To minimise impacts to the community, works will be completed on one half of the intersection at a time.

From Monday, 16 September 2024 access between The Springs Road and Princes Highway will be temporarily closed to all vehicles, including outside of working hours, for approximately 2 weeks. Light vehicle access to The Springs Road via local roads will not be impacted. Following completion of this stage of work, access between the Princes Highway and Burrungule Road will be closed to all vehicles for approximately 2 weeks while remaining works are completed.

Detours will be in place throughout the duration of works, please see detour map below.

The Princes Highway will remain open in both directions at all times.

Outside of working hours, lane restrictions on the Princes Highway will be removed. Speed restrictions will remain in place until all works are complete in late October 2024, weather permitting.

Local school bus routes and stops will operate as usual. On site traffic controller will guide buses through the work zone.

Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, follow the speed limits, signs/traffic control devices and drive safely to the temporary conditions.

We appreciate that these works have been ongoing for an extended period of time. We have experienced several program impacts throughout the upgrade, including inclement weather and contractor availability. We would like to again thank you for your patience and understanding while these critical upgrade works are undertaken.

All works at this location are expected to be completed in late October 2024, weather permitting.
