## South Road Tram Overpass Works notification

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) has completed the detailed design to rectify the Mike Turtur Bikeway section of the South Road Tram Overpass that was closed in January 2017.

Site works to install a lateral restraint system to complete the permanent repair of the structure **will commence on Tuesday 5 September 2017 and are expected to be completed before the end of December 2017.**

The department recognises the importance of South Road and the overpass to the community, including local businesses, residents, pedestrians, cyclists, public transport users and all road users. Every effort has, and will continue to be made, to minimise the inconvenience to stakeholders during this project.

While most of the works will be undertaken during the day between the hours of 7am and 5pm **any necessary road closures will be kept to a minimum and will occur late at night** in order to minimise disruption to businesses, road users and tram patrons.

To ensure the safety of all road users whilst heavy beams are being moved, **it will be necessary to close South Road to all traffic between the hours of midnight and 5am on two nights in early October, weather permitting.** Variable Message Signs will be used to advise road users to seek alternative routes during the closures. In addition, speed and lane restrictions will be in place on South Road for a couple of nights as the anti-throw screens are installed in late October / early November.

Advance notice signage will be in place to advise road users of changed traffic conditions.

Throughout the works, parking will be temporarily unavailable on Glengyle Terrace between South Road and Grosvenor Street, and on Norman Terrace for approximately 150m east of South Road. Pedestrian and cycling detours are currently in place and will remain unchanged during the works.

Some noise can be expected while these works are undertaken, however every effort will be made to minimise disturbance to local residents as much as possible.

Further information regarding any additional or future works will be provided as it becomes available.

Tram services will continue to operate as usual.
